Professor Milani will make a general presentation on how U.S. tax laws affect international visitors, and practical ways to save tax dollars and your time.

He will also explain how the International Tax Assistance Program helps Notre Dame's international community, and how special services are available for scholars, researchers, and faculty.

In general, anyone earning money in the United States must pay income taxes on the income earned.

Be sure you know what you can do now, before the end of 2019, to:

- Understand the help offered by the Notre Dame International Tax Assistance Program
- Understand the requirements and deadlines for submitting tax returns
- Protect your visa by preparing and submitting a tax return
- Learn about tax treaties. Depending on what country you are from, a tax treaty may reduce your income taxes.
- Increase the amount of possible tax refund you will receive
